MAYOR JAMES MELFI PRESENT

COMMENTS:

Councilwoman Martuccio asked where we are with the Wellman Theater? Mayor Melfi said the Wellman Theater has been applied for along with the bike trail from the Appalachian funding. Both are in process. The mayor said that is all he can report. He would like to have a final report for it beforehand. He said they feel very, very confident in the funding of both. It is very competitive. There is a lot of money there but it is very competitive.

Councilman Grumley said he was actually going to touch on the theater. Grumley asked if they get a copy of the architect drawing? Mayor Melfi said sure.

Councilman Moliterno said they had some updated information from the auditor tonight. He sees they spent \$173,000 so far on the city gym. The mayor said it is a big project. They are still doing the bathrooms as they speak. The mayor said he didn't know the total but he is not surprised about it. That is a total revamp of that city gym. We are talking asbestos in the plaster. We are talking removal of and insertion of windows. Specific types of dry wall. Vandal proof drywall. Not surprised at all at that. The mayor said he has to tell them that they rounded at about \$250,000 so he is a little surprised it's at \$173,000 but they will get to about \$200,000. Councilman Moliterno said that his only point is it's wintertime and it's used much more than it is at other times of the year. It would be nice to have it. He realizes they are working on the restrooms but the lion's share of the people that use it wouldn't use the restrooms anyway and they have them right outside in the hallway. It would be nice to have the volleyball back and some of the programs they used to have. Mayor Melfi said he has been pushing the contractor. He has been pushing them daily. They are not far away. There is going to be a different entrance to the gym. They don't want them coming off of Main Street. They don't want folks who are going to use the gym to walk across the floor and change their shoes. They want them to come in from this entrance where number one dispatch can view that whomever is entering and exiting and two they can go right to the locker room. The locker

rooms are getting some touches that are similar to the 60s and 70s where they are barricaded, and they can change their shoes there. They don't want anyone coming in with street shoes on that floor. The mayor said everything is new top to bottom. Literally top to bottom. Floor to ceiling and all new lighting. As a matter of fact he thinks that's pretty good.

Councilman Zirafi said he thinks the mayor answered that about how soon the bathrooms might be finished. The mayor said it could be a week from now. He has to take down.....he's been working on it.
